Please Read Carefully:

- After this form has been completed, send it to the Administrative Office at: 533 South Fremont Avenue, 6th Floor, Los Angeles, CA 90071-1706.
- Send in only one form unless there is a change of Beneficiary.
- **If you do not wish to designate the same Beneficiary for all Trusts, you may request separate Beneficiary forms.**
- This form is the only document that the Trusts will accept regarding your choice of Beneficiary. For example, if you subsequently execute a will or obtain a dissolution of marriage, those documents or court orders will not be effective to change your designated Beneficiary for Trust benefits. You must instead contact the Trust Office and sign a new Designation of Beneficiary Form.
- Your designation revokes all prior designations.
- If you name two or more Beneficiaries: (1) Two or more surviving Beneficiaries will share equally, unless you provide for unequal shares. (2) If only one Beneficiary survives, we will pay the total death benefits to that Beneficiary.
- If a minor (a person not of legal age), or your estate, is the Beneficiary, it may be necessary to have a guardian or a legal representative appointed by the court before any death benefit can be paid.
- A power of attorney must grant specific authority, by the terms of the document or applicable law, to make or change a Beneficiary designation. If you have questions, consult your legal advisor.
